- 3. Attach the green center tray to the midpoint of the uprights.
- 4. Attach the black top tray to the top of the uprights.
- 5. Tighten the fasteners on each tray completely.

- 6. Carefully rotate the cart so that the underside of the bottom tray is accessible.
- 7. Install the swivel casters on the handle side of the cart (suggested layout, the caster configuration can be altered to operator's preference).
- 8. Install the fixed casters on the side opposite to the handle (suggested layout, the caster configuration can be altered to operator's preference).
- 9. Carefully rotate the cart so that the cart is upright on a level surface. Lock the swiveling casters, so that the cart does not move.
- 10. Attach the handle.


